Background to some APP discussions UK - Argentina

- Many discussions and collaboration over many years
- Interest in APP in Argentina has varied in the last decade
- Discussions at City, Province and National level - with politicians, administrators and major Argentine companies
- Most countries in S America are actively looking at PPP ("APP" or "PPS") as a way of increasing FDI and improving infrastructure and public services
- A London example follows.....

London 2009-10 – success in Mass Transit and Traffic Congestion Control

Oystercard

- World's most successful mass transit card
- 10 million cards issued
- 4 million users
- 9 million journeys per day
- Self-funding system
- Successful PPP
- Revenue increase (+40% N. London line 2007)

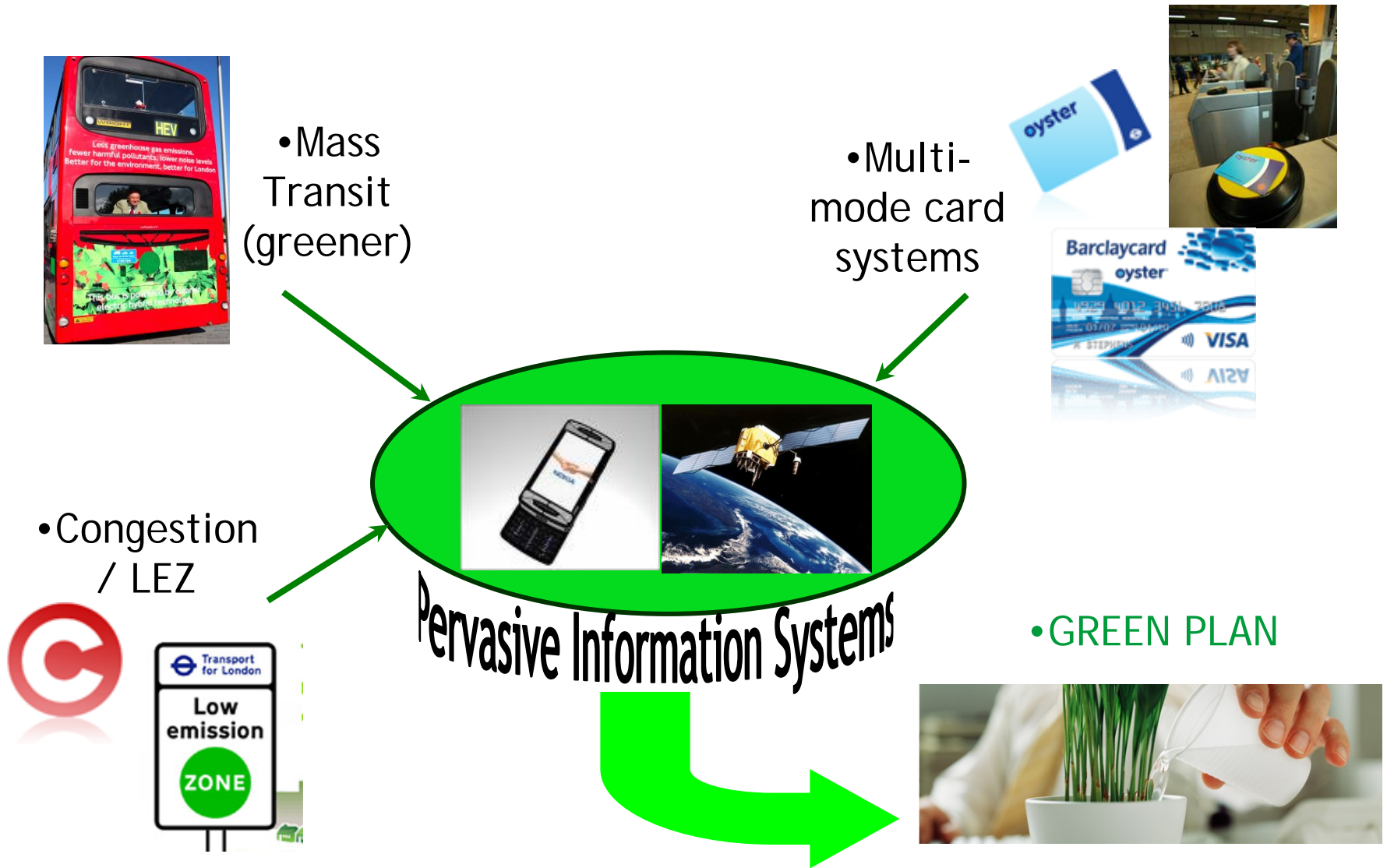


CCLondon

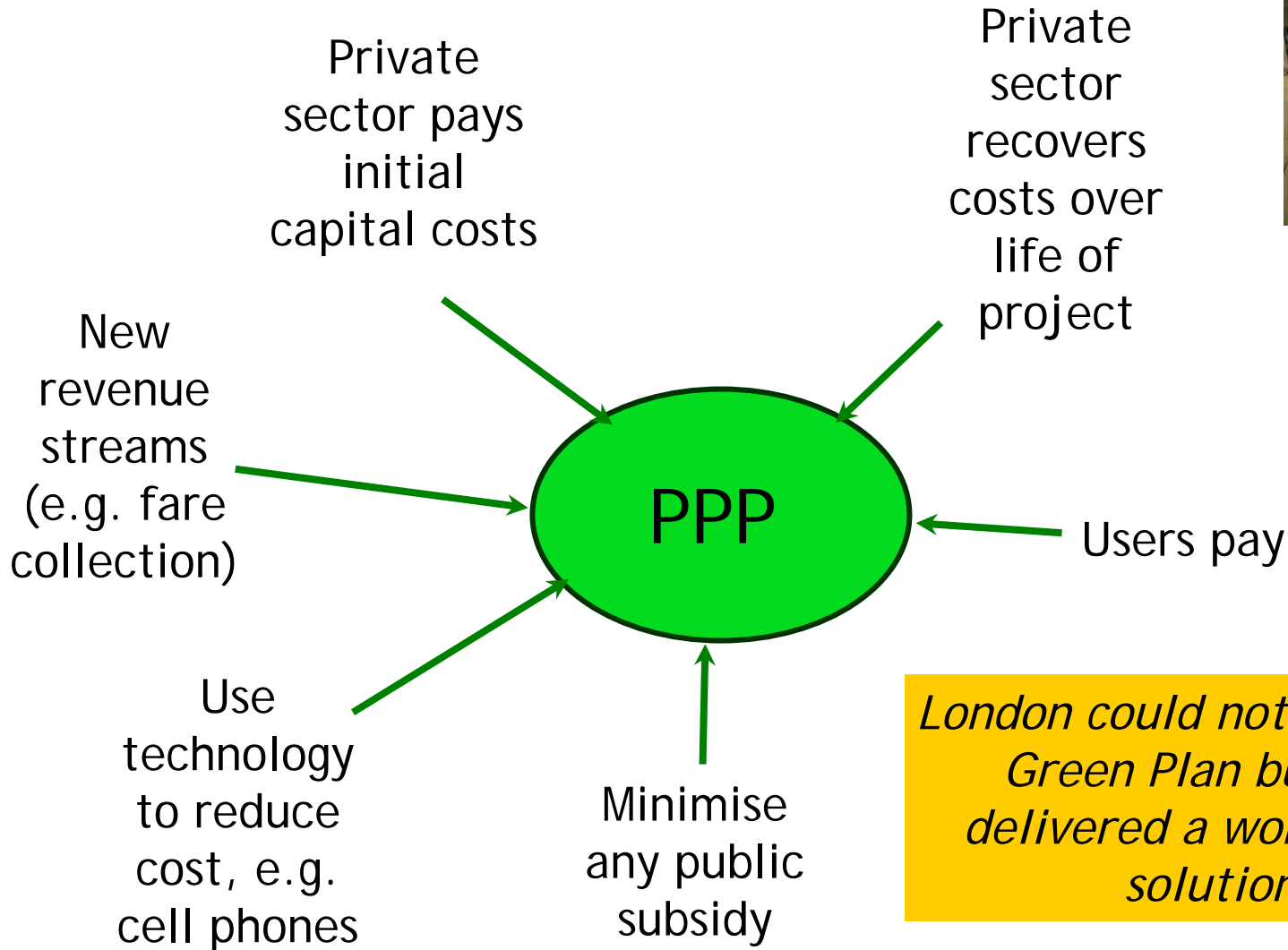
- World's most successful congestion charge
- 40,000 vehicles/hr drive in CC zone = 25 Motorway lanes
- Cut traffic levels by 15%
- Cut vehicle delays ("congestion") by 30%
- System captures 1.5 million events per 12 hours
- Positive traffic effect even outside the zone
- Now an "LEZ" Low Emission Zone for all Greater London
- Self-funding



London (or Buenos Aires?) next decade - Pervasive Systems enabling Green Plan

London could not afford its Green Plan but PPP delivered a world class solution

Carbon Impact of Change



If 15% of vehicle drivers shift to car-sharing, public transport or bicycle* - and 1% take up home-working.....

- 4.8 Megatonnes of CO₂ saved per annum
- Valued at €23 / tonne**, worth £82 million p.a.
